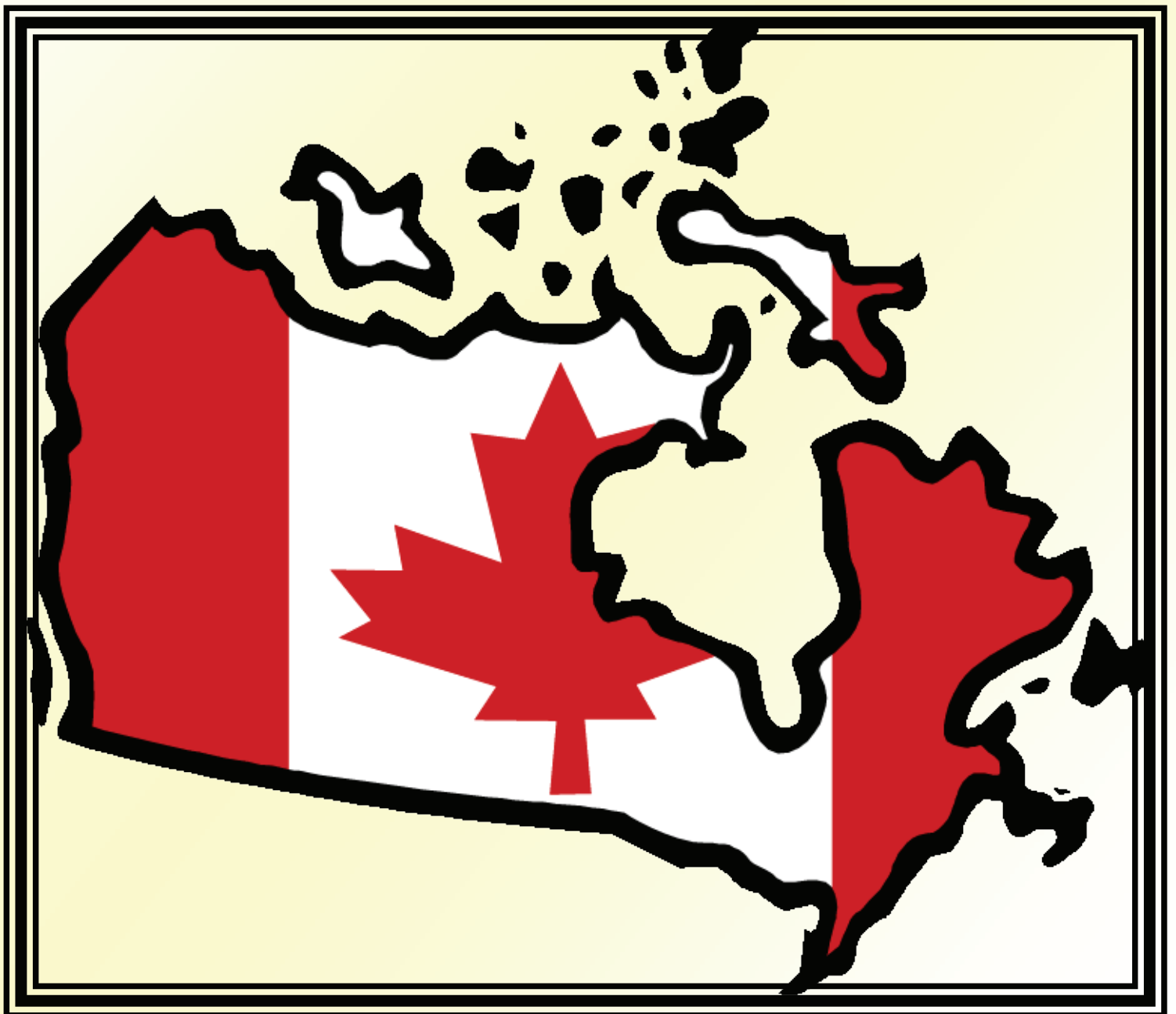

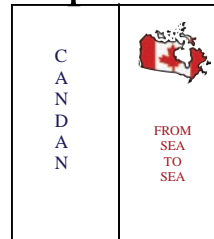

# Mini Lapbook

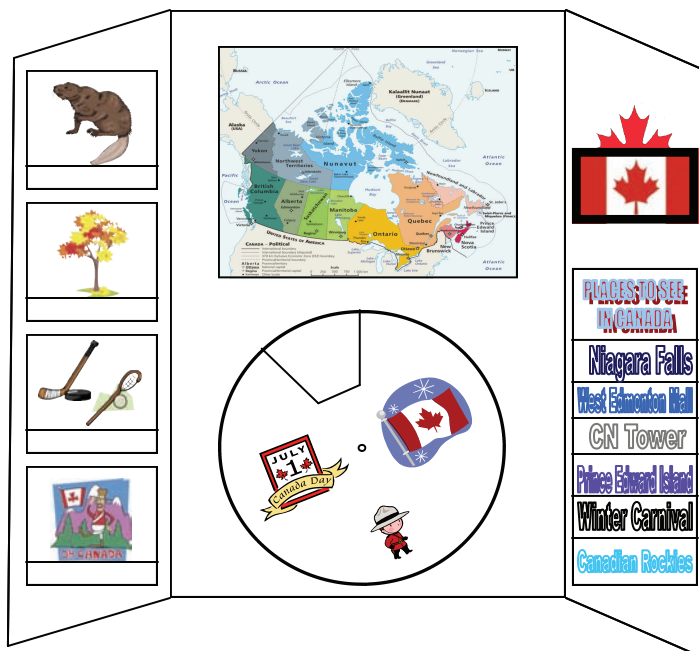
## Directions:

# WHERE IS CANADA?



Canada is the northern neighbor of the 48 continental United States of America. It is surrounded by three oceans: the Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, and the Arctic Ocean.

Canada is made up of 10 provinces: British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island (P.E.I.), and Newfoundland and Labrador. It is also made up of three territories: Yukon, Northwest, and Nunavut territories.

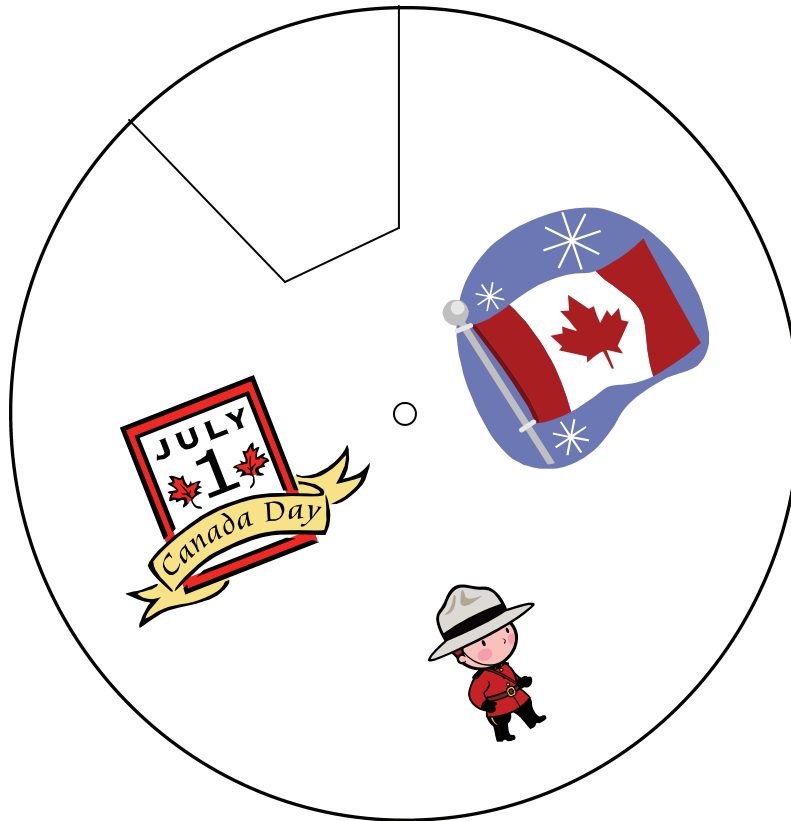
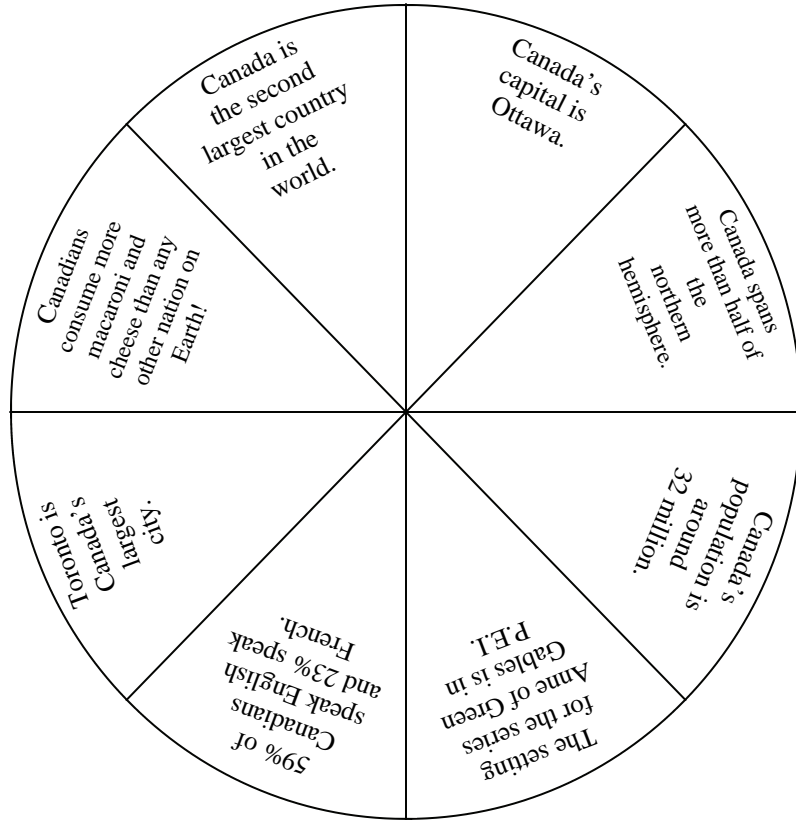
