DIRECTIONS

1. Print Pages 3-6.
2. Cut apart the picture cut outs on page 6.
3. Read the story. You will begin this activity where it says “Start” on page 3. As you read have the child place appropriate picture cut outs into the *Lines of Time* story boxes. They will be placed inside the dotted square. Use glue to adhere.
4. Continue this process on pages 4 and 5.
You may also wait until the story is finished being read and do this activity for memorization.
5. Check the *Lines of Time* by using the Answer Key on Page 7.
6. Three hole punch your completed *Lines of Time* and place into a binder or simply place into a folder.

TIPS:

- ~Use Cardstock for the *Lines of Time* pages. This helps preserve this project for future use. You will also want to do this IF completing the next tip.
- ~While these pages can be used independently, you may also want to cut the left side of pages 4 & 5 on the dotted line and tape (packaging tape works the best) the papers together. Just line up the “continue to next page” line and the “continue” line. Fan Fold this to fit into a binder. This will make one continuous line.
